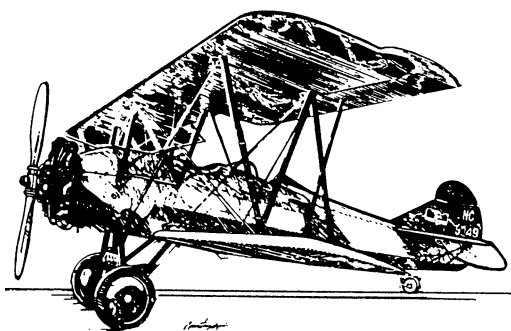


HARVEY AVIATION MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



PURPOSE: The Harvey Aviation Memorial (HAM) Scholarship Program was created in memory of Eldon and Richard Harvey, members of family owned Harvey Field in Snohomish, WA. The program recognizes qualified aviation students and fulfills a commitment by the Harvey Family to encourage and assist individuals seeking a **Commercial Pilot Career**. Recipients are selected on the basis of the criteria set forth in this handout without regard to race, color, sex, religion, or national origin.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: The awards are determined quarterly by the HAM Scholarship Committee relative to the annual budget. Awards may be used for tuition, enrollment fees and books directly related to the flight training aviation program. Scholarships are not renewable; however one can reapply to the program each year eligibility requirements are met. No more than one scholarship shall be awarded to each individual annually.

SOURCE OF FUNDS: The program operates solely on private and/or corporate donations.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Those meeting the eligibility requirements are invited to submit the appropriate application request in person, on line or via surface mail. Only those applications received by the declared deadlines will be considered.

Applicants should take special care to answer each question on the application as completely as possible and to sign the affirmative section of the application. HAM Scholarship Committee reserves the right not to process applications found to be incomplete as of the application deadline.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Students are eligible to apply for funds if they.....

1. Are 18 years of age or older and are pursuing a Commercial Pilot Career.
2. Hold no less than a valid student pilot certificate with a solo endorsement.
3. Hold a current FAA medical certificate.
4. Hold a Class III medical for Private or Instrument scholarship consideration, and Class II for all courses pursued above the Private/Instrument.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The HAM Scholarship Committee has sole responsibility for selecting recipients based on criteria as set forth in the application and the scholarship program handout. All Flight Training scholarship recipients receive their flight training at Snohomish Flying Service located on Harvey Field at 9900 Airport Way, Snohomish, WA 98296.

ACCESS TO APPLICATION MATERIALS: Information received through the application process will be strictly confidential and made available only to authorized persons associated with the scholarship program.

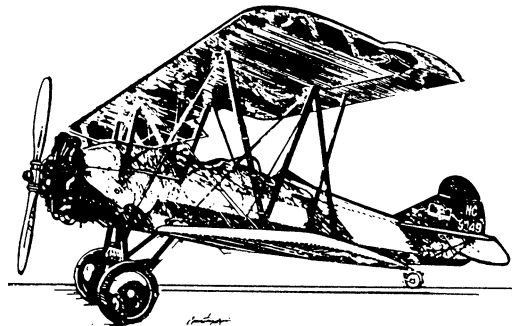
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINES: March 30, June 30, September 30, December 31

OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS: Scholarship recipients are required to submit a completed, signed "Flight Training Scholarship Application and Program Handout" as soon as possible to the ELHAMSC, to be eligible for participation in future ENHAM Scholarship Programs.

DISTRIBUTION AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: Scholarship recipients only will be notified. Please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to HAMSC if you would like to be notified of the results. Four Scholarships per year will be awarded. The scholarships are disbursed quarterly. The funds are disbursed to the scholarship recipient and the flight training facility jointly.
