



PACIFIC PAVEMENT AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

PURPOSE: The PACIFIC PAVEMENT AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP Program (PPAS) was created to recognize and reward qualified aspiring aviation flight students. The program also fulfills an obligation to encourage and assist individuals in selecting aviation as a career. Recipients are selected on the basis of the criteria set forth in this handout without regard to race, color, sex, religion, or national origin.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: The awards are determined quarterly or annually by the Aviation Scholarship Committee, relative to the annual budget. Awards may be used for tuition, fees, books or supplies directly related to the aviation flight program. Scholarships are not renewable; however one can reapply to the program each year eligibility requirements are met. The training takes place at Snohomish Flying Service at Harvey Field, an FAR Part 141 Approved Flight School.

SOURCE OF FUNDS: The program operates solely on private and/or corporate donations.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Those meeting the eligibility requirements are invited to submit the appropriate form/request. Only those applications received no later than the last day of each quarter; March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31 will be considered

Applicants should take special care to answer each question on the application as completely as possible and to sign the affirmative section of the application. PPAS reserves the right not to process applications found to be incomplete as of the application deadline.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Students are eligible to apply for funds if they:

1. Are 18 years of age or older.
2. Have no less than a valid student pilot certificate.
3. Have a current FAA medical certificate.

A Third class medical is required for Private or Instrument Scholarship consideration, First class for ATP, and Second class for all other flight training courses.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The PPAS has sole responsibility for selecting recipients based on criteria as set forth in the application and the scholarship program handout. All Flight Training scholarship recipients receive their flight training at Snohomish Flying Service located on Harvey Field at 9900 Airport Way, Snohomish, WA 98296.

ACCESS TO APPLICATION MATERIALS: Information received through the application process will be strictly confidential and made available only to authorized persons associated with the scholarship program.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINES: March 31, June 30, September 30, December 31

OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS: Scholarship recipients are required to submit a completed, signed "Flight Training Scholarship Application and Program Handout" as soon as possible to be eligible for participation in future Scholarship Programs.

DISTRIBUTION AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: Scholarship recipients only will be notified. Please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to PPAS if you would like to be notified of the results. Four Scholarships per year will be awarded. The scholarships are disbursed quarterly. The funds are disbursed to the scholarship recipient and the flight training facility jointly.

SELECTION PROCESS and TRAINING FACILITY

The PACIFIC PAVEMENT AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP (**PPAS**) has sole responsibility for selecting recipients based on criteria as set forth in the application and the scholarship program handout. All Flight Training scholarship recipients receive their flight training at Snohomish Flying Service located on Harvey Field at 9900 Airport Way, Snohomish, WA 98296.

DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS AND RECIPIENT ACCOUNTABILITY

Four Scholarships per year are awarded. The scholarships are disbursed quarterly in amounts of \$ 500 TO \$1000 per quarter. The funds are disbursed to the scholarship recipient and the flight training facility jointly. The recipient and the training facility are required to submit a short progress report to PPAS on a quarterly basis.

AUTHORIZATION

I grant permission for the School (Snohomish Flying) in which I am enrolled to provide and discuss my student records, in confidence with authorized individuals from **PPAS**. I understand I may also be required to interview and discuss personal matters and career goals with authorized individuals from **PPAS** as part of this scholarship application process.
