HIGHER EDUCATION

LIBERTY UNIVERSITY Snohomish Flying Service, Inc. is a Flight Training Affiliate with Liberty University's School of Aeronautics for airplane training. TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

BOEING EMPLOYEES Boeing's Learning Together Program (LTP) and Quality Through Training Program (QTP) will pay tuition and eligible expenses toward individual courses, certificate programs and degrees as well as cover part of the cost toward obtaining your pilot's license and reimburse exam fees for select certifications. VA (Veterans Administration) EDUCATION BENEFITS/GI BILL You may be eligible to use your benefits for flight training if you qualify for Post-9/11 GI Bill, or Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty, or Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve. You must also have a Private Pilot's license and hold a second-class medical certificate. Snohomish Flying Service is approved for providing flight training with VA education benefits. STUDENT LOANS

BLOCK TIME DISCOUNT

BLOCK TIME is money paid in advance in increments of \$2000.00 or more. Block time must be paid by cash, check or debit card and you will receive a 5% credit to your account on the deposited amount. Block time gives you the convenience of a charge account with credit showing. You must maintain a credit balance at all times to receive the 5% credit and to charge flight training to your account. We will be glad to provide you with a printout of your account activity at any time upon your request. Unused block time credits are non-refundable and account refunds will be charged a \$20 handling fee. A 3% surcharge will be applied to all credit card transactions.

Block Time discount is not available to I-20 or other Non-U.S Citizen Applicants
